indefinite pronoun  
any person

Strong's <sup>G444</sup>  
ανθρωπος 'anthropos'  
man-faced i.e. a human being  
Anthropos is used (1) generally, of a human being, male or female, without reference to sex or nationality.

v43-44a " Ye have heard that it hath been said, 'Thou shalt love thy neighbour [Leviticus 19:18] and hate thine enemy. But <sup>JESUS CHRIST or LORD</sup> I say to you, ' <sup>G25</sup> Love your <sup>G2190</sup> enemies ... "

Strong's <sup>G25/26</sup>

αγαπαō / αγαπῆ  
to love / love (10a) Love seeks the welfare of all

(11) Christian love, whether exercised toward the brethren, or toward [men] generally is not an impulse from [human beings] the feelings, it does not always run with the natural inclinations, nor does it spend itself only upon those for whom some affinity is discovered

Strong's <sup>G2190</sup>

εχθρος

from a primary 'echthō' (to hate)  
hateful (passive = odious, active = hostile)  
as a noun → an adversary, an enemy  
Echthros, an adjective, primarily denoting "hated" or "hateful" hence, in the active sense, denotes "hating, hostile"  
It is used as a noun signifying an "enemy"
